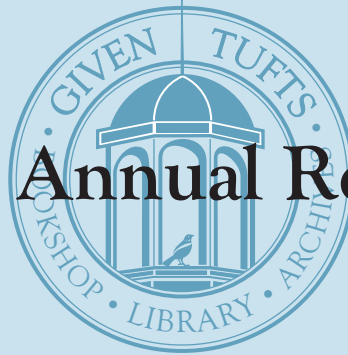

Libraries and museums are community anchors, and play an integral role in the local community. In 2016, the American Library Association released the “State of America’s Libraries” report. The report noted that in 2012, 92.6 million people attended over 4 million programs offered by public libraries and stated that “2/3 of Americans agree that libraries are important because they improve the quality of life in a community, promote literacy and reading, and provide many people with a chance to succeed.”

We at Given Tufts know that libraries touch peoples’ lives in many ways. We continue in our efforts to mirror the needs of our diversifying community. Given Tufts is Our Tufts Archives

TUFTS ARCHIVES

After the Tufts family sold Pinehurst, Inc. to the Diamondhead Corporation in the early seventies, Richard Tufts was anxious to preserve the family’s extensive and unique collection of documents, images, ledgers, correspondence and all manner of business and personal objects and archives. With funds from the Tufts Family Foundation, Richard S. Tufts endowed the Tufts Archives, an addition to the rear of the Given Memorial Library. Forty-two years later, the collection continues to grow. In 2016, we were pleased to receive archival items pertaining to John Derr, and the Maples golf family, and added to our collection of drawings, sketches and historical material from several Donald Ross designed golf courses.

MUSEUM

Many of our objects and artifacts are displayed in the Tufts Archives within beautiful hand-crafted wooden display cases, or glass cabinets beneath sparkling chandeliers and Palladian windows. Last year, we had over 4,000 requests for information, 3,000 of them made in person. Our locals brought their family and friends, and we had visitors

from places as far-flung as Germany, China, Estonia and the United Kingdom, as well as all the 50 states and Canada. They were assisted by our staff and volunteers, who gave tours and answered questions. In 2016, we had over 1,000 volunteer hours, and we brought in over \$23,000 in book and image sales.

GOLF

The Tufts Archives has sketches or drawings from more than 200 golf courses that Donald Ross designed, re-routed, or added holes, most of them done in his own hand. Many golf course architects make the Tufts Archives an important stop in their education and design planning. Last year we were visited by Richard Mandell, Chris Spence, Kyle Franz and Gil Hanse, in the pursuit of their Donald Ross course restorations.

With the assistance of the Donald Ross Society, we began a campaign to get the written histories of the Ross courses, and grew our collection of Ross pin flags to the point that we have no room to display them.

PROGRAMS

We presented 26 programs last year, at the Tufts Archives, or on location. The subjects ranged from the history of Pinehurst, golf in Pinehurst, the ladies of Pinehurst, the turpentine industry, to the Village greenery and landscaping. The groups ranged from life-long learning clubs, senior citizens groups, garden clubs, PEO, Silver Foils, grade school children, and Our State Magazine at Pinehurst. We gave several walking tours of the Village, sharing the rich local history.

HISTORY

As a result of collaboration between Sarah Given Larson and Richard S. Tufts, the Given Memorial Library opened in 1964, in memory of Sarah's parents, John and Irene Given. Since then the library has continued to present the best educational programs, technology and service, striving to meet the needs of our rapidly changing population and demographics. The Given Memorial Library and the Tufts Archives are a 501©3 entity. They do not receive federal or state funds.

COLLECTION

Given Memorial Library currently has 6,800 library card holders, about one half of the population of Pinehurst. In 2016, we had 541 new patrons and over 36,000 visits. We have a physical collection of 17,000 holdings, including hard covers and 1,300 books on CD. This number does not include our weekly and monthly periodicals (5 newspapers and 20 magazine subscriptions.) In addition to our physical collection, valued at \$300,000, we offer access to 10,000 free e-books, digital audio books, videos and magazines through Overdrive, and access to 50 digital magazines through Zinio. We also subscribe to Universal

Class, a service that offers 500 continuing education classes, many offering CEU credits. Our digital services are accessed through our website (www.giventufts.com) and with your Given Memorial Library card number. Overdrive, Zinio and Universal Class are services that we purchase for our patrons.

EVENT INFO

Last year Given Tufts presented "An Evening with the Generals," a dinner and discussion with three highly decorated generals: General William "Buck" Kernan, General Raymond F. Odierno and General Lance N. Smith. We partnered with the Pinehurst Resort to present a Hickory Golf Tournament on the No. 3 Course and, in cooperation with The Carolinas Golf Association,



"Green Friday," on famed No. 2 Course. We held the Holly & Ivy dinner at the Holly Inn in December and served an historic resort menu recreated by Chef Thierry Debailleul. Given Tufts supported the Village of Pinehurst at Live After 5 in the spring and, once again in the fall, providing free pumpkin decorating for the children.

OTHER PROGRAMS

Given Memorial Library increased the variety and frequency of programs in 2016. The Given Outpost provided a great location to repeat our day-time programs in the evening. More than 1,100 people attended our programs last year, including Gathering at Given, a popular favorite since 2009 that showcases the talents and specialties of community members. We are proud of our Book Buddies program, a continuing partnership with Pinehurst Elementary School at the library. In addition to our weekly Story Time on Thursdays, we began Super Saturdays for kids and their families. We proctored 146 Distance Learning Exams and have a notary public. RECYCLED READING

In 2004, Friends of the Library opened a used book shop, with all proceeds going to Given Memorial Library. Given Book Shop made money from the very beginning.

The Pinehurst community has been generous in donating books – it’s definitely a community of readers! The bookshop sells fiction, hardback and paperback, non-fiction and a limited number of children’s books, plus puzzles.

After a brief closure in August of 2014, the Book Shop reopened

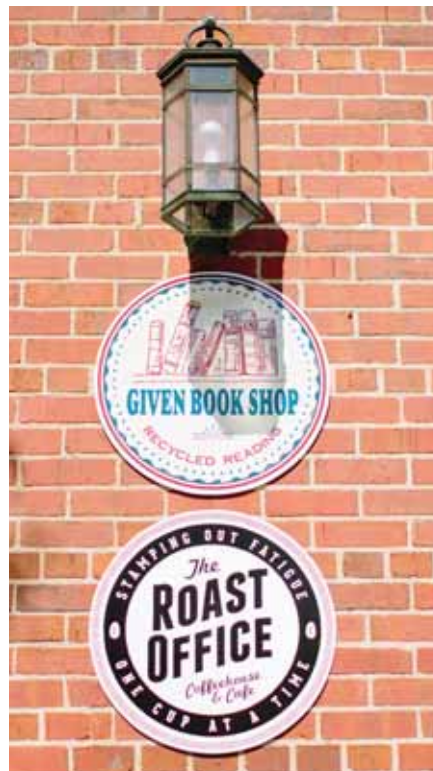
in April of 2015 in the newly renovated “old Post Office” building in the Village. Given Memorial Library has rented the building long-term and renamed it The Outpost. It now houses Given Book Shop and our tenant, The Roast Office. Given Book Shop is open 6 days a week, 10 am – 4 pm; at other times there is an “honor system” Donation Box enabling customers to purchase books at any time The Outpost is open.

Given Book Shop, staffed entirely by volunteers, has provided over \$600,000 to the library since opening in 2004. Given Tufts is

grateful to the community for its support, and to its customers, both residents and visitors.

PROGRAMS

Given Tufts offered free or reasonably priced continuing programs at both the Library and Given Outpost/Book Shop. “Action at the Outpost” partners with a local business and is activity based (painting, floral arrangement). “Book Buddies,” a partnership between Pinehurst Elementary School and our volunteers, meets in the Library and assists students having reading difficulties. The “Saturday Kids Program” has activities that promote reading and highlight specific themes. The “Gathering at Given” presentation/lecture series informs the community on wide-ranging topics from understanding Islam, successful container gardening to holiday decorating and more, all from local experts. In addition, a summer enrichment program gives local children the opportunity to learn and grow during summer vacation, spending valuable hours in the library. Weekly “Story Time” offers the very young the chance to visit the library, develop listening skills, and be creative with a craft.

SUPPORTING GIVEN TUFTS

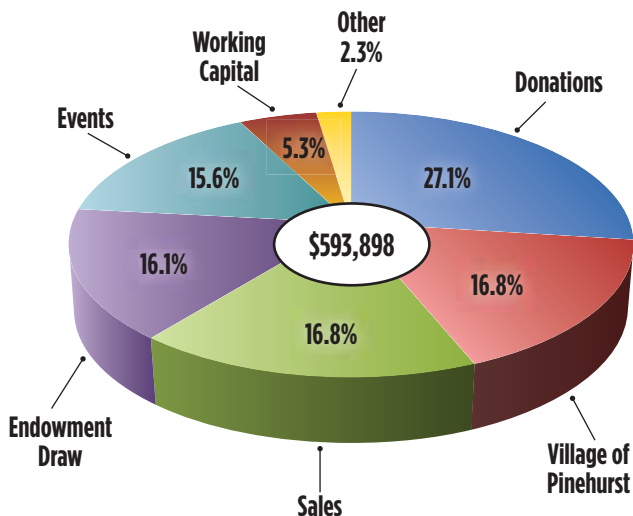
SOURCES OF FUNDS

Given Tufts is unique in many ways! First, the Given Memorial Library and the Tufts Archives (the Pinehurst History Museum) are housed in the same facility. Second, Given Tufts is funded in a manner that is unique among North Carolina libraries in that 83% of the funding for its 2016 budget of \$593,000 came from non-governmental sources. It is a private entity serving a public purpose, governed by an independent Board of Directors at great savings to local taxpayers. In contrast, in neighboring Southern Pines a library budget of nearly \$900,000 annually is fully funded by local taxpayers.

That “funding fact” is the reason that Given Tufts conducts an Annual Fund, offers public fund-raising events, provides for the sale of photographs and other items in the Tufts Archives, and operates the Given Bookshop, all of which combine to generate revenue essential to its high-quality programming.

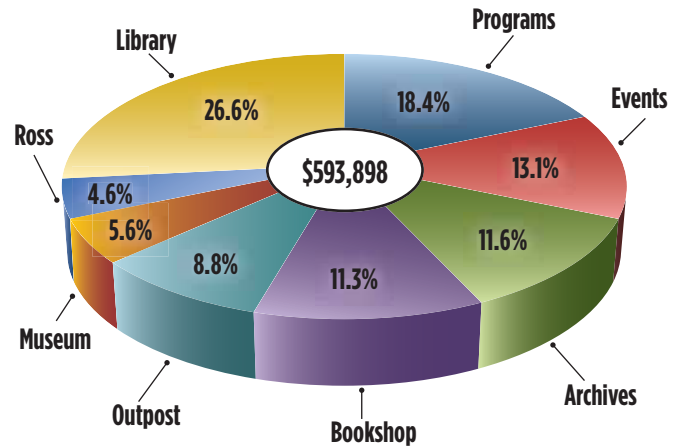
Given Tufts is grateful to the Pinehurst Resort for generously making available the use of its facilities for events that raise money each year, e.g. the use of Pinehurst No.2 for the “Green Friday” golf outing on the Friday after Thanksgiving and for the other ways it supports Given Tufts programs.

USES OF FUNDS

The Board of Directors and the staff, led by Executive Director Audrey Moriarty, are committed to good stewardship of the funds received. Their aim is to enhance programming of all kinds by operating as efficiently as possible in the use of both human and financial resources. The following chart reflects the results of their dedication in 2016.



VILLAGE OF PINEHURST

Financial support of Given Tufts by the Village of Pinehurst began in the 1990s with an initial grant of \$10,000 and has continued since, growing incrementally to its current level of \$100,000. The support of the Village in 2016, as in every year, was vital to the financial success of Given Tufts and accounted for 16.8% of total funding for the year. Given Tufts is most appreciative of that support, which has totaled \$580,000 since 2003.

That feeling of appreciation is reciprocated by both the Village Council and the residents and visitors who regularly enjoy the cultural and social benefits generated by the programs offered by Given Tufts. The Given Outpost, located in the former post office building since 2015, has been a special boon to the vitality of the Village center. The Given Bookshop and the independently operated Roast Office coffee shop have formed a popular gathering place for all.
